PATH OF PYRAMIDS

13 tetrahedron pyramids, painted & sculpted by local artists, are installed around Wheaton from the Westfield Mall to the new town plaza to the Wheaton Library. One pyramid was created with One Montgomery Green from non-recyclable plastics.

YARN BOMB

Crocheted by Wheaton area women and WAP artists, the Yarn Bomb decorates Wheaton lampposts along the Path of Pyramids.

COMMUNITY MOSAIC

Families from Wheaton's Latinx community worked with WAP artists to create a mosaic tribute to their Salvadoran heritage.
